Competition Guidelines: Each participant must memorize the couplets assigned to their age group. No repetition of couplets. English translation should be displayed at Ijtema.

Competition Guidelines: Each participant should select one Poem. Memorization is not required, and no couplet may be repeated. English translation of the poem should be displayed at Ijtema.

English Speech Competition

Competition Guidelines: Each participant should prepare one. Participants will have 3 minutes. There is a 15-second grace period. Nasirat will not lose points if their speech exceeds or falls short of the time limit by up to 15 seconds. The use of AI or ChatGPT is strictly prohibited, all written content should be the Nasirat's own words, unless quoting directly from someone else. References should be included.

Competition Guidelines: Arabic text and English translation is required

Handicraft Competition

Competition Guidelines: Work must be handmade. Craft should be appropriate to the child's age. Neatness, effort, and creativity will be appreciated. Name and age group should be written on the back of the craft.

Skill, neatness, and effort (sincere effort appropriate to Nasira's age)	10 points

Sports Competition

Competition Guidelines: Up to local Majalis

7-9 Age Group	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If possible, please arrange for matches in at least one of these sports: Volleyball, basketball, badminton, pickle ball, table tennis, soccer. ● Alternatively, plan for games like tug-of-war, 3-legged race, jump roping, darts, obstacle course, relay race. ● If none of these are possible due to space or other factors, please arrange for board games.

Ziafat Competition

Competition Guidelines: All food items must be prepared at home by the Nasirat alone. Mothers are not allowed to make items for Nasirat. No store-bought ready meals are allowed. Basic ingredients (such as flour, oil, spices, etc.) may be used. Food should be healthy, clean, and appropriate for your age group. Each participant must bring their own serving plate and spoon. No fire, stove, or electrical appliances are allowed at the Ijtema site.

Regarding the explanation, each Nasira should be able to explain and include with their food submission: Why the food item is considered healthy and the main ingredients used to create it. Explanations should be printed or written neatly out on a 3"x5" index card and placed next to their item. Names and age group of Nasirat should be on the back of the card.
