

TAHRIK JADID

“Who is it that will lend Allah a goodly loan that He may multiply it for him manifold? And Allah receives and enlarges and to Him shall you be made to return.” (Al-Baqarah 2:246)

In 1934, Majlis-e-Ahrar started an agitation against the Jama'at and declared that they would not rest until they had wiped the Jama'at off the face of the earth.

In response Hadrat Musleh Ma'ud^{ra} said:

“I see the earth slipping from under the feet of Ahrar. They say they will wipe out this Jama'at, but Allah Almighty has told me of a plan with which the Jama'at will spread in all countries of the world, and no one will be able to destroy it.”

So, at that time Hazrat Khalifatul Masih II^{ra} initiated Tahrik Jadid, concerning which he said:

“The purpose of launching Tahrik Jadid is to acquire such a fund with which Allah's message can be delivered as far as the corners of the earth with ease and facility.” (Friday Sermon, November 27, 1942.)

“Remember, Tahrik Jadid is from Allah Ta'ala and that is why it will prosper and all the obstacles in its way will be removed. And if provision for it is not found on earth, then the heavens will bless this scheme. Therefore, blessed are they who unreservedly participate in this scheme, because their names will live on in the history of Islam with respect and honor. These people will have great honor in the court of Almighty Allah because they went through great trials in order to fortify the faith and Allah Himself will safeguard their descendants. And divine light will issue from their hearts and will illuminate the world.” (Alfazal vol .15, No. 283)

LAJNA IMA'ALLAH GOAL

Our goal is 100% participation. Therefore, all Lajna, Nasirat & children under 7 years of age (boys and girls) should be encouraged to contribute to this scheme no matter how nominal it may be. The goal is also for lajna, nasirat, and children to raise ⅓ of the total jamaat collections.

DAFTAR SHASHUM (REGISTER 6)

In 2023, Hazrat Khalifa-tul Masih V^{aba} initiated Daftar Shashum (Register 6) and emphasized that every new convert to the Jama'at and every newborn, infant and child, especially Waqf-e-Nau, who have not yet been enrolled in the Tahrik Jadid scheme should be enrolled in Daftar Shashum. In the USA, Lajna Ima'illah has been given the responsibility of Daftar III. To achieve the goal set by Hazrat Khalifa-tul Masih V^{aba} an additional report has been included in our program so we can have a complete and comprehensive list of members enrolled in Daftar Shashum (Register 6). Hazrat Khalifa-tul Masih^{aba} also expressed the desire that members of Daftars 2, 3, 4, and 5 should revive the accounts of their grandparents and great grandparents who took part in Daftar Awwal and keep this Daftar open by paying on their behalf. The list of participants in Tahrik Jadid is divided into Daftars or registers. Daftar Awwal (Register 1) lists all those who joined the scheme from 1934-1944; Daftar Dom (Register 2) from 1944 to 1965; Daftar Saum (Register 3) from 1965 to 1985, Daftar Chaharum (Register 4) from 1985 to 2004 and Daftar Punjam (Register 5) from 2004-2023 and Daftar Shashum from 2023- present.

Tahrik Jadid DAY

Please hold at least one Tahrik Jadid Day every year. This may be held as a separate event or as part of a scheduled meeting. The purpose of this event is to inform Lajna and Nasirat about the history, importance and achievements of this blessed scheme and to increase participation.

Suggested Activities for Lajna:

- Presentations on Tahrik Jadid Scheme – purpose, history, achievements etc. workshop or discussion on —The Nineteen Demands of Tahrik Jadid and discuss how they may be implemented today.
- Give out a survey to see which Daftars your members belong to; find out if any family members belong to Daftar Awwal.
- Share memorable experiences connected to Tahrik Jadid sacrifices, especially senior members.
- Recognize new members to the Daftar Shashum in monthly meetings. Collect pledges from Lajna and Nasirat.

Suggested Activities for Nasirat:

- Older Nasirat can do presentations on the importance and benefits of Tahrik Jadid.
- Younger Nasirat can research and present on mosques which were built during each Daftar.

GUIDELINES FOR REPORT SUBMISSION

The Tahrik Jadid reporting form will be shared with the Local Sadr and Local Tahrik Jadid secretary via Google docs each year. The required information should be directly entered into the Google sheet and no formatting changes should be made to the sheet.

Please note that the actual date of birth is required for Daftar Shashum report. Please capitalize the names of all Daftar Shashum members (first, last and middle names) in the report.
