
LAJNA CONSTITUTION TALEEM



- **Secretary Taleem Mulk:**
- It shall be the duty of Secretary Taleem to take every possible measure **to spread religious and secular education among Lajna.**
- Secretary Taleem should prepare a program for the education of illiterate women and children in the Jama'at so that each woman and child can read and write. Secretary Taleem shall also give reminders on the importance of educating boys.

SECRETARY TALEEM MULK...(CONT'D)

- Secretary Taleem shall draw the attention of Majalis towards the following:
- Teaching and **reading** of the Holy Quran (**Nazira**)
- Teaching of **translation** of the Holy Quran
- **Memorization of Salat** along with its translation
- Reading of **books written by Hazrat Masih Maood^{as}**.
- Secretary Taleem shall be responsible for making arrangements for preparing and conducting examinations of Lajna members according to the syllabus prescribed by Lajna Ima'illah.






IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

- Prepare a two-year syllabus based on the Shura proposal of last two years
- One workshop in each quarter to hear different viewpoints from members.
- Prepare an Ijtema syllabus to have discussion on these topics in a sisterhood environment.
- Prepare a PowerPoint for Virtual and in person LMC.

EXAMPLE



- A monthly based Taleem Syllabus gives the Lajna members a chance to revise the Quranic verses Hadith and Malfoozat on the particular subject matter.
- A workshop every third month will give a chance for Lajna members to brainstorm actively instead of passive reading, on the same topic.
- To read Holy Quran with correct pronunciation, a **Tarteel rule** should be revised in meeting.
- To understand the translation of the Holy Quran a **word meaning box** and **light grammatical translation** is available for advance readings.




EXAMPLES

- A **Taleem test** is mandatory to assess the knowledge acquired by members on a yearly basis. It is an open book test that gives a chance of overview and learning the subjects.
- An **Optional Holy Quran test** is an opportunity to test your translation skills for the Holy Quran.
- Tarteel and translation classes are given daily and on weekly basis on alfurqan.us .
- local, Regional and National Ijtema is held annually to promote sisterhood while learning new information.

- Secretary Taleem shall be responsible for the setting tests of Ahmadi ladies in accordance with the syllabus prepared by Lajna Mulk.


Incorporating the Name of Allah into our Daily Expressions



Promised Messiah (as) said that,

“The name ‘Allah,’ which is the personal name of God Almighty and which is that compendium of all perfect attributes, ... It is said that this is the Greatest Name (isme-azam) of God and it possesses tremendous blessings.” (Malfuzat Vol I, pg 97)

Those who sincerely believe in God behold the spectacle that every single atom falls under the authority of God to the extreme that even the hair on our head is numbered. On the contrary, the condition of today’s educated people is that they consider even saying insha’Allah [God willing] in their conversations to be against civility. Read book upon book—not so much as the name of God is anywhere to be found, but the time has now come that God Almighty demands the realization of His existence. (Malfuzat Vol 9 , pg 13-14)
