Ongoing Tabligh Activities

- Promote tabligh enthusiasm and vigor in all Lajna members by conducting ‘Booster workshops/tabligh refresher courses’, mini tutorials on FAQ’s and jeopardy. These activities will help to eliminate lack of confidence, enhance knowledge, increase awareness of information regarding tabligh initiatives, familiarize Lajna members with websites and reference guidelines from The Holy Qur’an, The Bible and archives of Friday Sermons.
- Emphasize the Eighth Condition of Bait as a fundamental guideline to becoming a successful Dai’Illalah: “That he/she shall hold faith, the honor of faith and the cause of Islam dearer to him/her than his/her life, wealth, honor, children and all other dear ones.”
- Lajna members should organize peace symposiums and Interfaith events. Include topics on Modesty and Holy Quran teachings. Plan ‘True Islam Awareness Week’ as well as ‘Hijab - An Armour of Respect and Dignity’ and ‘Overcoming Racial Injustice through Unity’.
- Eradicate misconceptions regarding Islam portrayed in the media and anti-Ahmadiyya Campaigns by communicating with friends and colleagues and organizing peace symposiums on relevant topics such as ‘Empowerment of Women’ and ‘Women as Advocates of Peace in our Nation’ (Tabligh guidelines as per Lajna Constitution)



- Incorporate guidelines from Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih V (aba)'s book *World Crisis and Pathway to Peace* regarding – 'Loyalty and Love of One's Nation.' Outline how Islamic guidelines on gratification and benevolence towards the needs of our neighbors/local community members leads to the propagation of peace amongst the nation at large.
- Elaborate the fundamental Islamic teachings of modesty - a means of strengthening the dignity and respect of women in society and reducing moral corruption, as opposed to a hindrance or restriction to freedom of women. Modesty leads to marital harmony and cultivating peace in homes.
- Work with the Nasirat Secretary and Umoore Talibaat Secretary to introduce tabligh activities amongst Nasirat and young Lajna groups in their schools- this will develop an interest and aspiration to do tabligh from an early age, promoting an increase in future Dai' Illallah.
- Although there is no mask mandate in most areas and in-person activities have resumed, COVID is still a concern so always offer guests the option of masking and social distancing

- Lajna Imaillah USA Centenary celebrations - 1922-2022
- Organize exhibitions and historical displays and invite Tabligh contacts to celebrate the centennial achievements of Lajna Imaillah USA
- Present guests with literature and Lajna Centenary souvenirs

Guidelines for Tabligh Activities

- Convey the message of Allah so it is most acceptable to the opponent, pray continually and enhance your knowledge with guidance from the Holy Qur'an. "Make religion easy for others to follow; do not make it difficult. Similarly, present religion in a pleasing manner; do not make it repulsive to others." (Muslim)

- Never be disheartened by lack of response or feel abandoned and defeated in your tabligh efforts.

“But if they turn away, We have not sent thee as a guardian over them. Thy duty is only to convey the message...” (Ch 42 V 49)

“So keep on admonishing people. Surely, admonition is, indeed, profitable.” (Ch 87 V 10)

- The essence of tabligh is not to feel incapable due to lack of knowledge or experience. The best form of tabligh is to be a role model of a good human being according to Islamic teachings- guide people to Islam by reforming yourself first; instill the practice of regular Salat with a particular emphasis on congregational Salat and Tahajjud prayers, daily recitation of Holy Qur’an with translation, routine giving of Sadaqa, and spending as much time in Zikre-Ilahi and Istighfar as possible.

- Impress tabligh contacts by your example of being humble and honest and develop a pleasant, affectionate and empathetic personality.

“A believer should use proper etiquette in tabligh. Being harsh when leniency is called for is unwise, similarly, sometimes only harshness can prevail, being lenient at that time is wrong...The Holy Prophet (saw) also received a similar command. There should be leniency and affection among the believers.” - Hadhrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as).

“The art of speech is to be learnt and as regards the art of speech, Allah has guided us to make use of righteousness. The more the person is God fearing, the more will his/her words be effective...more knowledge is of no avail. Hence it is required of friends, to add to their speech, they elevate their personal standard of righteousness.” (Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih IV - Friday Sermon July 1987)

- Aim to establish friendship and mutual understanding and respect each other’s beliefs prior to focused tabligh discussions, as Islam teaches respect for all human beings and abandons inequality or injustice.

“To select a few friends during a year, to treat them with special love and affection, to explain to them slowly and gradually why you are different from others, and to let them take interest in your person, and then convert personal interest into an interest in Jamaat...is not difficult at all. Once you have the initiative and pray for it, you will also learn to do it.”(Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih IV-Friday Sermon 11/06/1987)

- Observe purdah and be prepared to answer questions about modesty and the spiritual benefits of wearing the Hijab.
- It is crucial that women should NOT engage in one-on-one tabligh discussions with men, even if they are in purdah – they can guide the men to contact the local missionary or jamaat tabligh secretary.
- Avoid controversy particularly when initially conducting tabligh discussions; focus on commonalities amongst yourselves and the opponents.

“And argue not with the people of the book except what is best as an argument but argue not at all with such of them as are unjust. And say, ‘We believe in that which has been revealed to us and that which has been revealed to you; and our God is One, and to Him we submit.’” (Ch 29 V 47)

Quarter 1 April-May-June 2023

Theme: Recitation Fuels My Soul

Objective: Restore and strengthen your bond with Allah through Recitation of The Holy Quran, understanding its profound message and sharing the teachings of The Holy Quran with Tabligh contacts.

Activities:

1. Host an Interfaith Iftaar dinner at your mosque - Share the Spiritual, Moral and Physical benefits of Fasting as mentioned in The Holy Quran. Give your guests a tour of the mosque and present them with gifts and literature relevant to the month of Ramadan.

2. Organize Interfaith discussion events to share the spiritual beauty and profound benefits of reciting the Holy Quran. Invite different faith representatives to share their Holy scriptures.

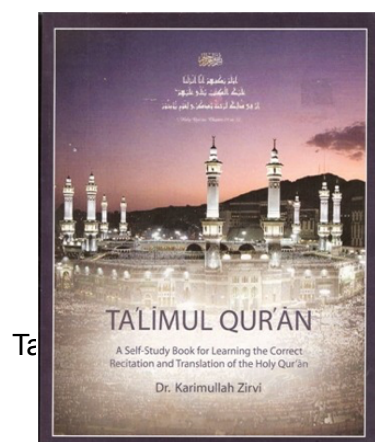
3. Conduct a Holy Quran Exhibition - display the different translations of Holy Quran and specific prayers and prophecies. Include exhibits and literature about Lajna Ima'illah Centenary (1922-2022).

4. Mosque Tours: invite Other Faith Representatives to Visit Our Mosque and express an interest in visiting their place of worship.

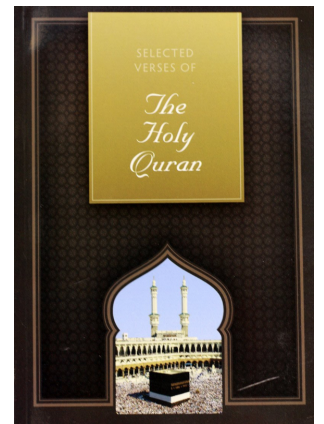

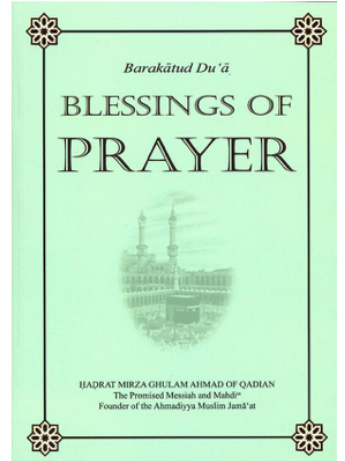
Activities:

Quarter 6 July-August-September 2024

Theme: Hijab is my Identity

Objective: To enlighten all other religions with the beautiful teachings of Modesty prescribed in the Holy Quran.

Activities:

Tabligh

1. Organize Interfaith discussions on the topic “Modesty - A shield against Exploitation”, ‘The historical and religious significance of the Veil’. Refer to our [Lajna Ima'illah USA website for a power-point resource](#).
2. Invite Tabligh contacts to a ‘Women's Tea/Interactive discussion’ or ‘Hijab Day’ at the mosque about:
 - a. “Journey towards Modesty - Hijab my strength.”
 - b. Share personal journeys of wearing the Hijab.
 - c. How wearing the Hijab maintains the dignity of women (enhances inner beauty and strength of faith).
3. Organize a few outings to allow groups (seven or more) of lajna and nasirats to show the society the modesty/dignity/empowerment of Muslim women wearing their hijabs. Example outings: Cinema, Mall, Botanica Gardens, Bookfairs, Arts and Crafts shows, or other community events. The larger the group the more attention from non-Muslims. Have brochures in your purses on Islam and Lajna to distribute if the situation occurs.

Quarter 7 October-November-December 2024

Shaddad ibn Aus relates that the Holy Prophet (saw) said: A wise person is one who watches over himself and restrains himself from that which is harmful and strives for that which will confront him after death; and a foolish one is he who gives rein to his cravings and seeks from Allah the fulfillment of his vain desires (Tirmidhi).

Objective: Address the Islamic concept of introspection and analyzing our shortcomings - A means to reform, excel in good deeds and elevate our Spiritual status.

Activities:

Tabligh

1. Excel in serving humanity- Collaborate with Khidmat e Khalq Department to continue working on the 'Are you OK?' Initiative by checking on the wellbeing of vulnerable, elderly and needy people in our community
2. Organize an Interfaith event or "chai and chat" on 'Reflection on our journey towards Faith', 'Actions which revive the strength of our faith.'
3. Conduct a Book Club on the 'Philosophy Of The Teachings Of Islam'.
4. Liaise with Secretary Sehat Jismani to hold an "Tabligh walk and talk" on the topic of 'Gratitude,' such as for health, nature, etc., ensuring all participating Lajna are observing purdah.

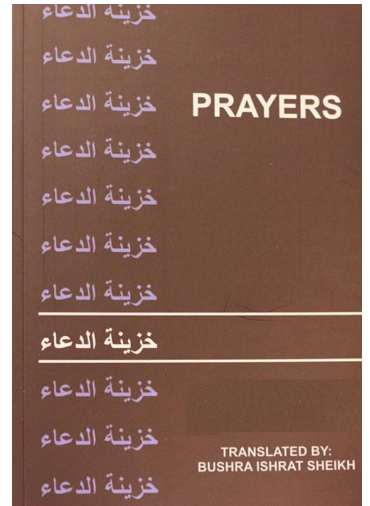

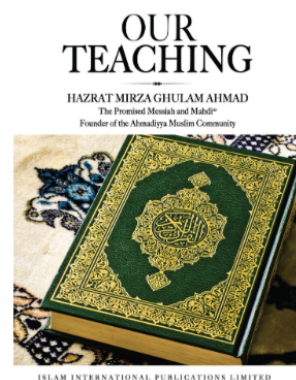
